Welcome to another great year!

Every year parents' number one question is how do you handle 15 to 20 three- and four-year-olds? Hopefully, these simple ideas will help everyone have a successful and fun year.

Children will be more likely to follow rules if they see parents following rules.

Clothing:

Please make sure your child is able to master whatever attire he/she wears to school. Elastic waist pants are the easiest for children to master. They are not able to work most snaps, buttons or belts. They get very frustrated when they have problems in the restroom. Please keep this in mind when choosing school clothes. Cowboy boots and flip flops are forbidden in the parent handbook. Why? Just think of 36 kicking feet under a lunch table wearing cowboy boots. They kick each other and it hurts! Flip flops are not allowed. Why? They are dangerous. Children run, trip and fall. Please dress your child in comfortable and practical clothing. Shorts should always be worn under dresses. Please label all removable articles of clothing. Jackets, sweaters, etc. All children must have 2 changes of clothing always, labeled in a zip lock bag in their cubby.

Toys Brought to CWM:

Do not bring toys from home. As you can imagine, this creates classroom problems. The only exception is show-n-tell day. Please keep these items educational and theme related. They are only allowed to get these items out of their bag during that time.

Lunch time:

We will not cook or heat any food in the Friendly Frogs. Please remember to send a spoon/fork when needed. Finger foods work best. Precut foods into bite size pieces. Please send a drink or water as well. Please do not send open mouth drinks for lunch, they spill often. We encourage you to drain fruit cups at home and peel/cut fruit at home. Imagine the kids waiting for us to open or peel for 15 kids. If you are sending juice, please already have it poured in the cup for lunch. We have 25 minutes for lunch. Please encourage your child to eat and not play during this time. Label all lunch boxes and cups. I recommend putting an ice pack inside the lunch box.

Water Cups:

You will need to send a water cup each day with your child. (See Water Cup Sheet)

Rest your body:

Each child will need to bring a nap mat of some sort to school each week. (Please label) It will be sent home once a week to be washed. No pacifiers are allowed in the Friendly Frogs, but lovies are welcome to be sent. Some children still need a full nap at this age, while others may not. We are flexible so just let us know what your child needs. They must all rest quietly for 30 minutes on their nap mat.

Potty Assistance:

All children entering the Friendly Frogs MUST be potty trained and NOT be in a pull up. We are not responsible for potty training. We encourage independence in the restroom. We high five and praise those who are self-sufficient. Keep in mind that they may look somewhat twisted when they are picked up, but we have praised them highly for their efforts. We ask that at home you encourage your child to use the restroom alone. They should be able to wipe themselves.

Birthdays:

Parents may bring in a special treat for the birthday boy/girl. The best treats are cookies or cupcakes. (Must be store bought) You may purchase pizza for lunch if you wish. We can celebrate during snack or lunchtime. Please talk with your child's teacher in Brightwheel to schedule.

Crafts:

We cut, glue, paint, color, etc. please do not send your child in an item of clothing that you do not want ruined. We try our best to use washable products and protect all clothing but, sometimes accidents do happen.

Labels:

Label EVERYTHING that comes to school!

Bring to school every day:

Lunch box and drink, nap mat, daily folder, show-n-tell on Friday, and a water bottle or cup to refill with water throughout the day.

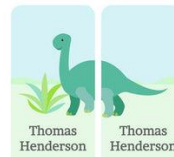
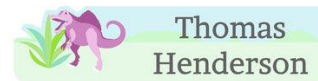
